

DEATH CLAIMS NELLIE STALEY

Mrs. James K. Staley Dies After An Extended Illness

Mrs. Nellie Daniels-Staley, 44, wife of James K. Staley, died last night at her home on North Sixth street, following an extended illness.

Death was due to carcinoma. She had been ill for more than two years.

The deceased was born in Preble, June 24, 1894, the daughter of Joseph and Minnie Daniels. She was a registered nurse, a member of the First Christian church and of the American Legion axillary here.
