Mrs. Catherine M. Stalter, 75, of 148 1/2 South Second Street, and a lifelong resident of Decatur, died at 3:40 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been a patient for the past three weeks.

She was born in Decatur April 25, 1897, a daughter of Nathan L. and Harriett Butler-Roop, and was married to Dorus A. Stalter Nov. 28, 1914. Her husband preceded her in death Dec. 11, 1971.
