Evangeline Steele is taken by death

School Teacher dies at county hospital

Miss Evangeline Steele, 37, for 8 years a teacher in Adams Co., schools, died at 9:10 pm Wed., night at Adams Co. memorial hospital. Death was caused by meningitis after an illness of one month. She was born in Adams County Novemeber 17, 1904, the daughter of Jess H. and Niffie Cowen-Steele. She graduated from the Pleasant Mills high school in 1924 and from Manchester collage in 1926. She was a member of the Pleasant Mills Methodist church.
