Margaret Stonestreet, 64, of 620 Grant street, widow of Charles M. Stonestreet, died at 3:25 p.m. Monday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where she had been hospitalized four days. She was a member of the Starcher Baptist Church, North Charleston, West Virginia. Born in Smithers, West Virginia, on May 5, 1913, she was the daughter of Mont and Lelia Perry-Shanklin and was united in marriage on March 2, 1929 to Charles M. Stonestreet, who died December 31, 1969. She lived in Decatur 14 years. Survivors include four children, Charles H. Stonestreet, route 5, Anthony Wayne Meadows; Jack L.
