Harold E. Strahm, 63, Rt. 8, Decatur, an employee of the Decatur General Electric Co., was dead on arrival at 1:55 p.m. Tuesday at the Adams Memorial Hospital.

He was stricken with an apparent heart attack while at work at the local GE plant.

Mr. Strahm was a member of the Zion United Church of Christ and a trustee of the church. He was a veteran of World War II.

Born on Jan. 26, 1918, in Adams County, he was the son of Philip and Lula K. Scherry-Strahm, and was married to Jean Oliver on Oct. 11, 1947; she survives.

Also surviving are one son, Terry E., Indianapolis; two daughters, Mrs. Malcolm (Donna) Miesse, and Mrs. Dan (Debra) Harman, both of Fort Wayne; three sisters, Mrs. Raymond (Martha) Kolter, Rt. 5, Decatur; Mrs. James E. (Selma O.) Myers, Decatur; Mrs. Harold (Dorothy) Scherry, Rt. 8, Decatur; and four grandchildren. One brother preceded him in death.

Funeral services will be held Friday at 10:30 a.m. at the Zion United Church of Christ, Rev. Lawrence E. Balleine officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur Cemetery.

The body will lie in state at the church one hour prior to services.
