Mr STRICKLER, who was active in the affairs of the Republican party and a former precinct committeeman, died unexpectedly at 10:10 p.m. Monday at L. W. Blake Hospital, Brandenton, FL.

He was a retired International Harvester Co. Supervisor, leaving there in 1966. He was a member of the Decatur Church of God and the Decatur Cemetery Board.

Born in Decatur on 21 June 1905, he was the son of C Gilbert and Golda SHOAF-STRICKLER, and was married 12 December 1926, to Mabel DUNIFON who survives.
