

LAURA A. STRICKLER DIES AT HOSPITAL

Miss Laura A. Strickler, 82, of 835 Mercer avenue, a former employee of the Adams county memorial hospital, died at 2:45 p.m. Sunday at the hospital following an extended illness. Her condition had been critical for the past week.
