LAWRENCE STRICKLER DIES SATURDAY NIGHT - Funeral Services Tuesday

Lawrence H. Strickler, 68, retired farmer of south of Decatur, died at 10:15 o'clock Saturday night at the Adams county memorial hospital after an illness of several years.

A lifelong resident of Adams county he was born in St. Mary's township Feb. 1, 1881, a son of George and Jane Thatcher-Strickler. He was married to Lena Cook Dec. 23, 1906.
