

Aaron E. Sudduth Dies at Hospital

Aaron E. Sudduth, 66, of 716 Schirmeyer street, died at 8:40 a.m. Sunday at the Adams county memorial hospital, where he had been a patient four days.

He was born in Decatur Dec. 2, 1905, a son of Elias and Sarah Gilbert-Sudduth, and was married to Dorothy A. Krick Sept. 14, 1929. His wife preceded him in death Sept. 30, 1968.
