Otho James Suman Dies Early Today

Funeral Services Sunday Afternoon

Otho James Suman, 90-year-old retired farmer, died at 12:45 o'clock this morning at his home, one mile south and one-half mile west of Pleasant Mills. He had been ill four months and bedfast for nine weeks.

A resident of St. Mary's township since 1891, he served as township trustee for six years, beginning in 1916.

He was born in Darke county, O. March 27, 1861, a son of George and Susanna Longman-Suman, and was married to Drusilla Brown March 27, 1883.

He was a member of the Methodist church at Pleasant Mills.

Surviving are his wife; one son, Harry Suman of Pleasant Mills; one daughter, Mrs. Mary Ross of Decatur; 16 grandchildren and 38 great-grandchildren. Two daughters, eight brothers and five sisters are deceased.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2 p.m. Sunday at the Pleasant Mills Methodist church, the Rev. Harley T. Shady officiating. Burial will be in the Decatur cemetery. The body will be removed from the Zwick funeral home to the residence, where friends may call after 2 o'clock Saturday afternoon.
