OSCAR TEEPLE, 82, DIES AT CARE CENTER

Oscar Teeple, 82, of route 1, Monroe, a retired farmer, died at 5:25 a.m. this morning at the Decatur Community Care Center. He had been a patient there since May 3.

He was a member of American Legion Adams Post 43; D.A.V.; and Veterans of World War I.

Born in Van Wert County, O., on Nov 4, 1890, he was the son of Henry I. and Rebecca Miller-Teeple, and was married to Mabel I. Cottrell, who preceded him in death on April 16, 1947.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Frank (Rebecca) Wales of Fort Wayne; two brothers, Albert Teeple of Elida, O., and Harvey Teeple of Berne; and one granddaughter, Cindy Wales. Four sisters and one brother preceded him in death.
