

JOHN TRIM DIED THIS MORNING

Paralysis Fatal To An Aged Resident Of This City; Funeral Wednesday

John Trim, aged 78 years, died at the Adams County Memorial hospital about 7:30 o'clock this morning. Mr. Trim suffered a stroke of paralysis last Thursday and this resulted in his death.

Mr. Trim was born December 25, 1846. He spent most of life in Adams county, residing for many years near Geneva. In 1867 Mr. Trim was married to Elizabeth Algar (sic) and to this union were born eight children. Mrs. Trim and three daughters preceded Mr. Trim in death. The children who survive are Mrs. Elizabeth Brandyberry, of Fort Wayne; Mrs. Lillie Hill, of Decatur; William Trim, of Decatur; Georges (sic) Trim, of Texa county, Oklahoma; and John J. Trim, of Kansas City, Missouri. Mrs. John Glutting, of Attica, Indiana is a sister. For the last two years Mr. Trim has made his home with his daughter, Mrs. Hill, in this city.

Funeral services will be held from the Hill residence at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon, the Rev. B. F. Dotson, pastor of the United Brethren church officiating. Burial will be made in the Maplewood cemetery.
