Ernest Tumbleson, 91, of route 4, Decatur, a retired farmer and former employe of the Adams County and Indiana highway departments, died at 2:35 p.m. Wednesday afternoon at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where he had been hospitalized three weeks.
