

Mrs. Lulia Walters Dies Friday Night

Mrs. Lulia M. Walters, 86-year-old Decatur lady, died at 9 o'clock Friday night at the Adams county memorial hospital following an illness of 90 days of complications.

She was born in Adams county March 20, 1876, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Isaac Smith, and was a lifelong resident of the county. She was married in 1896 to Delbert H. Walters, who preceded her in death.

Mrs. Walters was a member of the Calvary Evangelical United Brethren church.
