

Final Rites Monday for Oliver Walters

Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon for Oliver Walters, 88, lifelong resident of Union township, who died at 12:55 p.m. Friday at the Adams county memorial hospital. He had been ill for five years of complications.

He was born in Union township Jan. 22, 1874, a son of Henderson and Emaly Walters, and was married to Nellie Cramer March 4, 1897. His wife preceded him in death in 1936.

Mr. Walters was a member of the Union Chapel Evangelical United Brethren church.
