George McDonald, an inmate of the county infirmary, passed away Saturday morning after an illness of a short duration. He had been sick only about a week with typhoid fever and what is known as a parotid abscess on the right side of his face and what is supposed to have caused his death. For three years he was an inmate at the Easthaven asylum at Richmond and some time ago was returned to this city as being cured. He was but forty-nine years of age and has been a resident of this city for a number of years, and later taken to the infirmary, where he has since resided.
