Emily A. Gillum passed away at the home of her son Edwin who resides two miles southeast of Linin Grove.

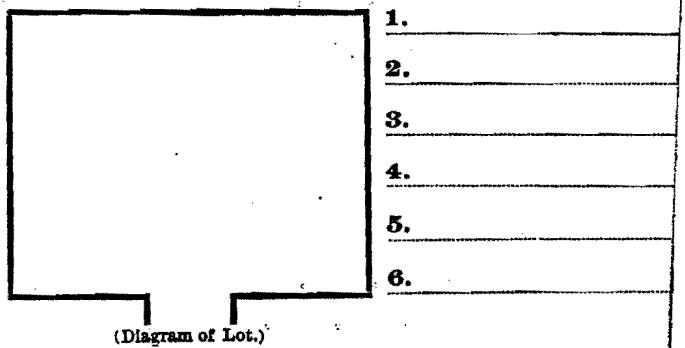
Funeral services at Linin town, Ohio where she is a member of a local church. She will be interred at Greenville, Ohio.
