WHEREAS David James, and Oliver James, of Delaware county, Ohio,

have deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Fort Wayne whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

David James, and Oliver James, according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the North half of the North East quarter of Section one, in Township twenty eight, North, of Range thirteen East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Fort Wayne, Indiana, containing sixty nine acres and eighty hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said David James, and Oliver James

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said David James, and Oliver James,

and to their heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said David James, and Oliver James,

and to their heirs and assigns forever,

as tenants in common and not as joint tenants.
