PROCEEDINGS TO READMIT TO A HOSPITAL FOR INSANE

State of Indiana, County of Adams, Sct:

Personally appeared before me, Clerk of the Superior Court of said county, Doctor L. P. Harshman a reputable physician, who is licensed to practice medicine in this State, who, being duly sworn, declares that he is acquainted with Glenola H. Sovine of said County; that said Glenola H. Sovine was formerly adjudged insane, that she was a patient of Richmond State Hospital from the 10 day of March A. D. 1941 to the 20th day of June A. D., 1941. that Glenola H. Sovine is now insane, and a proper subject for treatment in a Hospital for Insane, and that conveyance to a hospital for insane will not endanger the life of said Glenola H. Sovine patient, as appears from the following symptoms personally observed, namely: Ideas of being poisoned, hatred of husband and baby. Escapes from reality. Hebephrenic grimaces, Illogical deductions.

and from the following symptoms described by others, namely:

Careless about house & home. Indifferent. Has some insight. Feels she might be better off by going back to sanitarium. Talks about divorce, etc.

ORDER TO CONVEY PATIENT—RE-ADMISSION

State of Indiana, Adams County, ss: To the Sheriff of Adams County, Greeting:
