

BARKLEY, BEULAH I.

Second lieutenant, Army Nurses' Corps, N-767 384. Born 20 June 1908 in Union Twp., Adams Co., Ind., the daughter of Jacob C. and Elva M. (Nidlinger) Barkley. Employed as school nurse, Plymouth. Enlisted Mar. 1943 and entered service 1 June 1943. Training: Fort Knox, Ky., Camp Forrest, Tenn. Sent overseas (to England) Feb. 1944; (to France) July 1944. Died at Ste. Mere Eglise, France, 27 July 1944 from asphyxia. Buried temporarily in U. S. Military Cemetery, Blosville, France; later in I. O. O. F. Cemetery, Monroeville, Ind.
