

FRIEDT, EUGENE LEROY

Ensign, U. S. Naval Reserve, 326 094. Born 2 Mar. 1919 at Pleasant Mills, Ind., the son of Jack and Rosa C. (Mauler) Friedt. Married 29 Mar. 1944 to Dorothy Arnold of Indianapolis. Teacher, Daleville; residence, Decatur. Enlisted in Naval Reserve at Ball State Teachers College 20 Jan. 1942 and assigned to V-7 training program (Serial 626 16 45). Training: aviation cadet, U. S. Naval Reserve Flying Service, Iowa City, Iowa, Feb. to May 1943; U. S. Naval Aviation Service, Lambert Field, St. Louis, Mo., May to Aug. 1943. Received his wings and was commissioned ensign at Pensacola, Fla. Left the United States in June 1944. Killed 14 July 1944 in a plane accident at sea.
