

HOLLOWAY, ROBERT LEON

Private first class, Co. A, 333d Infantry, 84th Division, 35 549 492. Born 28 Oct. 1923 at Fort Wayne, Ind., the son of Murray and Zula (Steele) Holloway. Student, Ball State Teachers College; residence, Pleasant Mills. Inducted 3 Mar. 1943 and entered service 10 Mar. 1943. Assigned to Medical Department and sent to Camp Robinson, Ark. Selected for Army Specialized Training Program and sent to Lafayette College in Pennsylvania. Upon discontinuance of this program, he was assigned to the 84th Division. Sent overseas Sep. 1944. Campaigns: Siegfried line, Ardennes, Battle of the Bulge. Killed in action 26 Dec. 1944 in the Ardennes salient, Belgium. Buried temporarily at Fosse, Belgium, later at Decatur.
