DEATH CLAIMS CHAS. ALESHIRE

Wabash Township Farmer Dies at His Home Near Berne

Charles Lee Aleshire, 77, a resident of Wabash township for the past 25 years, died this morning at 1:45 o'clock at his home, two and one-half miles south of Berne.

Death was attributed to complications. He was born in Virginia January 31, 1862, the son of Reuben and Sarah Brubaker-Aleshire.

Surviving are the widow and three sisters: Mrs. Lulu Vurner, Mrs. Mollie Shirley and Mrs. Susie Strickler, all of Virginia.

One brother and four sisters are deceased. The body was taken to the Yager funeral home and will be returned to the residence tonight. It may be viewed there until time of the funeral.

A short service will be held Monday afternoon and then at 3 o'clock at a chapel in Muncie. Burial will be in that city.
