Forest "Frosty" Baker [sic], 78, Monroeville, died at 1:35 p.m. Friday in Van Wert. He lived in Monroeville for the past nine years. He resided near Dixson, O., most of his life. He retired in 1968 from the plating department at General Electric Co., Fort Wayne, after 39 years of service.

He was born Nov. 14, 1903, in Van Wert County, the son of Ferdinand and Ida Clayton-Barker, and was married to Thelma Weisman; she died Nov. 5, 1970.

He was a member of the Bible Baptist Church, where he served as a deacon.
