Sarah Boyer's Brother Dies

Local People Attend Funeral at Orrville, Sunday.

Edward Boyer, of Albion, Mich., died at the Marshall County Home on Feb. 3 at the age of 65 years.

About two months ago, he had the misfortune to fall and break his hip. Other complications set in and caused his death. He was not married.

Two sisters survive: Mrs. Frank Wines of Gladwin, Mich., and Miss Sarah Boyer of Berne. The body was sent from Michigan to the H. C. Auble Funeral Parlors at Orrville, Ohio.

Funeral services were held Sunday at the funeral parlors. The pastor of the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church at Orrville, the Rev. D. H. Per Mar, officiated. Special music was furnished by the minister's wife and Mrs. Elmer Kerr.

Burial was made at the Orrville Crown Hill Cemetery, where the body was laid to rest by the side of his mother, Mrs. Rosina Hirschy Boyer.
