### **LOCAL WOMAN'S BROTHER DIES**

Freeman Brandyberry, 58, of Careysville, Ohio, which is a suburb of Rosewood, died at his home Monday evening following a stroke of paralysis. Mr. Brandyberry formerly lived near Monroe and was a brother to Mrs. Peter Bixler of North Jefferson street.

Mr. and Mrs. Bixler received a message Sunday that Mr. Brandyberry was critical. They were present when he passed away.

The deceased had been engaged in farming.

Surviving are the widow and a son, Clarence, and the following brothers and sisters: Mrs. Bixler of this place; Mrs. Peter Kessler of Colon, Michigan; John of Spencerville, Ohio; Leeman of Careysville, Ohio.

His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Sol Brandyberry, and a brother and a sister preceded him.

The funeral was held at Careysville this morning at 10 o'clock.
