## DIEHL FUNERAL RITES ARE SET

Funeral Rites Wednesday Afternoon for Mrs. Ervin Diehl

Funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon for Mrs. Verah Tarr Diehl, 39, of near Monroe, who died Monday at the Robert Long hospital in Indianapolis. Death was attributed to complications. She had been ill since last May.
