Rev. Vincent Ehinger dies this morning

Rev. Vincent X. Ehinger, 77, a native of Decatur and a Catholic priest for more than 50 years, died this morning at a hospital in Phoenix, Ariz.

Rev. Ehinger had been ailing for some time.

He was born in Decatur July 10, 1889, a son of Mr. and Mrs. E. X. Ehinger. His father for years was a bank cashier here.

Rev. Ehinger was ordained to the priesthood with the Passionist Fathers June 13, 1915, at the Immaculate Conception church in Chicago.

He celebrated the 50th anniversary of his ordination June 13, 1965, at the Chicago church, with many relatives and friends from Decatur attending.

Surviving is a sister, Mrs. William Berling of this city.

The body will lie in state at the Immaculate Conception church on North Harlem Avenue in Chicago from 4 p.m. Sunday until funeral services Tuesday morning.
