Mrs. Wilhelmina Graeber, 77, died at 10 a.m. today at her home near Woodburn after a long illness. Her death was hastened by a fractured hip received in a fall in her home five weeks ago. Mrs. Graeber was a member of the Zion Lutheran Church in Woodburn. She had resided in Allen and Adams counties her entire life. Surviving are five daughters, Mrs. Emma Juergens, Mrs. Albina Bleeke, and Mrs. Luetta Leibundgut, all of Milwaukee; Mrs. Louise Juergens, of this city, and Mrs. Minnie Armbruster, of Woodburn; a son, Fred Grabemeyer, of this city; six sisters, and two brothers. Her husband, Fred Graeber, dropped dead of a heart attack last December 6 at Calhoun and Berry streets in this city. Funeral services will be held Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. at Zion Church in Woodburn with the Rev. H. J. Reinking officiating. Burial in the church cemetery. The body will be returned to the home Sunday afternoon from the Oetting Funeral Home in Harlan.
