Native of Decatur dies at Fort Wayne

Mrs. Antoinette (Nettie) Hindman, 90, of 4514 Arlington Ave., Fort Wayne, a native of Decatur, died at 6:25 p.m. Friday at St. Joseph's hospital, where she had been a patient since July 3.

The daughter of Joseph and Anna Wemhoff-Smith, she was born in Decatur, but had lived many years in Fort Wayne.

Mrs. Hindman was a member of St. John the Baptist Catholic church and its rosary society and Daughters of Isabella.
