ADAMS COUNTY NATIVE DIES

Jacob Klopfenstein Dies Sunday at Home in Burr Oak, Mich.

Jacob Klopfenstein, 76, a native of Adams county, died Sunday at the home of his son, Otto Klopfenstein, at Burr Oak, Michigan, according to word received here.

The deceased was born in French township, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Pete Klopfenstein, and moved to Burr Oak in 1911. His wife preceded him in death nine years ago.

Surviving are two sons, Otto and Emil; four sisters, Mrs. Mart Beuher of Arvilla, Mrs. John Rich, Mrs. Ferdinand Stauffer and Mrs. Fred Mathys, all of Berne, and two brothers, Samuel of Howe and Pete, of west of Monroe.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon at Burr Oak and burial will also be in that city.
