FRED KOHLER DIES SATURDAY AT FARM HOME Funeral Tuesday For Well-Known French Twp. Retired Farmer

Fred A. Kohler, 73, retired Adams county farmer, died at 3:20 Saturday morning at his home two miles east of Vera Cruz in French twp. Pneumonia was the cause of death. He had been in failing health the past ten months.

He was born in Adams county on Oct. 8, 1865, a son of Abraham and Anna Rudy Kohler. His marriage to Mary Moser took place at Berne on Dec. 19, 1901. Surviving besides the widow are two sisters, Mrs. Tobias Steffen, of Bluffton, R. R. 4,

and Mrs. Sophie Huffman of Winamac, and one brother, Alfred Kohler, of Adams county. Two sisters and one brother are deceased.

Funeral services will be held at the home at 10 a.m. Tuesday in charge of Rev. H. H. Meckstroth, of Vera Cruz. Burial will be in the M.R.E. cemetery at Berne.
