Gertrude Kreigel dies At Celina, O.

Mrs. Gertrude Kreigel, 41, wife of Edward Kreigel, of Celina, O., died at 9 o'clock Thursday night at the Gibbons hospital in Celina after an illness of three weeks of complications.

Born Aug. 2, 1919, she was a daughter of Andrew and Emma Gillig-Gass, and was married to Edward Kreigel in 1947.

Mrs. Kreigel was a member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic church in Celina, the Ladies Auxiliary and Altar society of the church.

Surviving in addition to her husband are her mother, Mrs. Emma Gass, former Decatur resident who resided with her daughter; four children, John Charles, Charlene and William, all at home, and one sister, Sr. Mary Cordelia, CPPS, of Cincinnati, O.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10 a.m. Monday at the Immaculate Conception church in Celina, with the Revs. Donald Gillig, John Gillig and Russell Gillig officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery at Celina. The body was removed to the Gillig & Doan funeral home in this city, where friends may call after 7 p.m. today until 12 noon Saturday. The body will be taken to the residence 124 East (rest is missing)
