

Louisa S. Kurber dies at Delphos

Mrs. Louisa Schurger Kurber, 88, native of Adams county and member of a prominent family in this community, died suddenly at 7 o'clock Saturday evening at her home in Delphos, O. She had not been ill and death was unexpected.

A daughter of John and Agatha Schurger, she was born in Adams county June 15, 1881, and was the last surviving member of a family of eight.

Her husband, Frank Kurber, preceded her in death in 1947. The family moved from Decatur to Delphos many years ago.

Mrs. Kurber was a member of St. John's Catholic church at Delphos.

Surviving are eight children, most of whom reside in the Delphos area, and a number of nieces and nephews and other relatives in Decatur and vicinity.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Wednesday at St. John's Catholic church in Delphos, with a grandson, Rev. Robert Kurber, and a nephew, Rev. Herman Schurger, celebrating the funeral. [rest is missing]
