Mrs. John Landrum, Jr., Dies At Home This Morning

Mrs. Oletha M. Landrum, 43, died this morning at 6:30 o'clock at her home in Monroe township. Death followed an illness of two years.

She was born near Danville, Illinois August 25, 1897, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Clark Brown. Surviving besides the husband, John Landrum, Jr., are four children, Ralph, Lewis, Helen and Janice, all at home; three brothers, Howard of Trenton, New Jersey; Addison and Robert of Harrisonville, New Jersey; three sisters, Mrs. Harvey Harshman of Continental, Ohio; Mrs. Hazel Foreman of Convoy, Ohio and Mrs. Lester Decker of Huntertown. One child is deceased.

Funeral services will be held Monday afternoon. A short service will be held at the Gillig & Doan funeral home at 12:45 o'clock and at 2 o'clock (CDT) at the U. B. church in McGill, Ohio, with burial in the Dealey cemetery near Convoy. Rev. Luke Martin of Decatur will officiate.

The body may be viewed at the funeral home after 7 o'clock tonight until time for the services.
