JUD McCARTHY DIES SUDDENLY

Owner of U. S. Package Liquor Store Dies of Heart Disease

Jud McCarthy, 50, owner of the U.S. Package Liquor store in this city, died unexpectedly Saturday of a heart attack at his home in Fort Wayne. Although he had been in poor health for some time, death was unexpected.

He was a native of Peru but had made his home in Fort Wayne with a cousin, Anna McCarthy, for the past four years.

He was a member of the St. Patrick's Catholic church and the B. P. O. Elks lodge at Peru.

Surviving are the widow, Lucy; a daughter, Mary Jane; two sisters, Miss Bee and Miss Anna McCarthy, both of Peru.

Funeral services will be held at the Costner & Bond funeral home in Peru at 8:30 o'clock Tuesday morning and at 8 [sic] o'clock at St. Charles Catholic church, with Rev. Paul Welsh officiating. Burial will be in the Catholic cemetery in Peru.
