

DEATH TAKES FRANK MOCK

Former Monroe Township Farmer Dies at Fort Wayne

Decatur, May 20 - J. Frank Mock, 76, native of this city and well known retired farmer, died Sunday morning at 2:20 o'clock at the Fort Wayne Lutheran Hospital. Death was caused by complications. Mr. Mock formerly lived near Monroe, on the farm where Elmer Beer now lives.

The deceased was born in this city February 10, 1861, the son of Jacob and Charlotte Eister Mock, both deceased. He was a member of the I. O. O. F. lodge of this city and of the Anthony Boulevard Presbyterian church of Ft. Wayne.

His wife, Nora, preceded him in death seven years ago. Surviving are the following children: Mrs. Webster Martz of South Webster; Clyde, George and Mrs. J. J. Ledford, all of Ft. Wayne. A sister, Mrs. Emma C. Longhenry, of Chicago and a brother, Lloyd Mock, of Monroeville, also survive.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home, 3010 Euclid Ave., with the Rev. A. P. Bourns officiating. Burial was made in the I. O. O. F. cemetery at New Haven.
