Sugar Beet Truck Driver is Killed

Charles Murray, 23, of Jay County, was killed instantly this morning near the Jay-Randolph County Line, when the truck he was driving left the road, crashed into telephone poles and caught fire.

He had returned to his home south of Portland with his father, John, after delivering a load of beets to the Central Sugar Co., in this city.

His father left the truck at their home and the younger man was enroute to Ridgeville at the time of the accident.

He is survived by the widow and the parents.
