Anthony Nesswald dies at hospital

Anthony J. Nesswald, 76, of 2508 Capitol Ave., Fort Wayne, a native of Adams county and brother of four Decatur ladies, died at 9 p.m. Thursday at the Lutheran hospital in Fort Wayne, following an extended illness.

Born in Adams county Nov. 18, 1895, he was a son of Godfrey and Anna Appelman-Nesswald. His wife, Loretta, preceded him in death in 1964.

Mr. Nesswald was a member of St. Paul's Catholic church in Fort Wayne, the Third Order of St. Francis and the Knights of Columbus. He was a veteran of World War 1.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Milton Brooks, with whom he resided; five sisters, Misses Agnes, Christina, Rose and Anna Nesswald, all of Decatur, and Sister M. Adelia of Fond du Lac, Wis., and four grandchildren.

Funeral rites will be held at 9:30 a.m. Monday at Mungovan & Sons South chapel, and at 10 a.m. at St. Paul's Catholic church chapel, with Rev. Donald J. Muldoon officiating. Burial will be in the Fort Wayne Catholic cemetery.
