THOMAS OLIVER DIES SUDDENLY

Well Known Man Dies at Hospital; Ten Children Survive

Thomas Oliver, aged 71, a resident of Adams County for 60 years, died at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, at Decatur, Sunday afternoon at 5 o'clock. Death was caused by anemia. He had been at the hospital 2 weeks.

Mr. Oliver was born in Darke county, Ohio, but spent most of his life around Monroe, in Adams county. His wife preceded him in death.

Surviving are the following children: Grover Oliver, Electa Oliver, both of Decatur; Walter, Francile, and Mrs. S. I. Rupert, Monroe; Gregg and Webster Oliver, Indianapolis; John and Rev. Mont Oliver, Detroit; Mrs. O. D. Kessler, Bluffton. One daughter preceded.

The funeral will be Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the Rupert home at Monroe, burial in Fairview Cemetery at Bluffton.
