BERNE WOMAN'S MOTHER DIES

Mrs. Fred Reppert, 87 of Vera Cruz Tuesday

Mrs. Louise Reppert, 87 died at 9:15 a. m. Wednesday at her home in Vera Cruz of complications following an illness of one week.

She was born in Preble township, Adams county, April 23, [year cut off], daughter of Mr. and Mrs. [first name cut off] Sellemeyer. On Nov. 3, [year cut off], she was married to Fred Reppert who died Dec. 31, 1928.

Surviving are seven children: Mrs. Rudolph Schug, of Berne; Mrs. Charles Walters and Mrs. [first name cut off] Yager, both of Vera Cruz; Mrs. John H. Fulk and Mrs. Jacob [surname cut off], both of Bluffton; Will Reppert of Monroe and Fred Reppert of Decatur. There are 25 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren surviving. Two brothers surviving are Herman and Fred Sellemeyer, both of Decatur.
