Albert Reynolds Dies Last Night

Father of Mrs. A. M. Biberstein Dies from Heart Disease

Albert Reynolds, 73, prominent Wells County farmer and the father of Mrs. A. M. (Elizabeth) Biberstein of near Berne, died at 10:45 o'clock Sunday evening at his home northwest of Vera Cruz. Death was caused by heart disease. He had suffered a heart attack last Monday while working in the garden and had been ill since.

Mr. Reynolds was born in Wells County July 12, 1868, a son of William and Elizabeth Reynolds. He married Alta Mae Emmons on February 10, 1894 and she preceded on February 23, 1906.

Surviving are two daughters and a son, Mrs. Biberstein of near Berne, Mrs. Frank Clark of Bluffton and Dwight K. Reynolds of south of Vera Cruz. Three grandchildren and a great-grandchild also survive.

Three brothers and a sister, Robert, Wesley, Alfred and Mrs. Mary Mowery preceded.

The body was taken today to the home of the son, Dwight K. Reynolds and will be kept there until time of the funeral. The rites will be held at 2:00 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at the Bethel Methodist Church southeast of Bluffton of which he was a member. Rev. H. H. Meckstroth will officiate and burial will be in the church cemetery.
