Injuries Fatal to Miss Reynolds

Dies at Wells County Hospital from Injuries in Auto Mishap

Mrs. Lillie M. Reynolds, 70, wife of Dr. Frances M. Reynolds of Montpelier, died at 4:00 pm Wednesday at the Wells County Hospital from injuries received in an accident Sunday morning when the automobile driven by her husband collided with a transport truck one mile west of Uniondale. Her daughter, Mrs. Earl St. John, 36, was killed instantly in the crash. Mrs. Reynolds had many close relatives in Berne and community.

Mrs. Reynolds, former resident of Nottingham Township, west of Linn Grove, suffered a fracture of the skull, fractures of the right arm and right leg and severe brain concussion. She never regained consciousness.

Her husband and daughter, Miss Grace Reynolds, 42; her son-in-law, Earl St. John, 35, and his son, Danny St. John, 13, were reported showing improvement at the hospital.

The decedent was born in Wells County June 2, 1872, to George W. and Hannah Kelley Schott and resided her entire life in Wells and Blackford Counties.

Funeral services were held at 2:30 pm today at the residence with Rev. G. D. Greer, pastor of the Methodist church in Montpelier, in charge. Interment was in the mausoleum in Woodlawn Cemetery, Montpelier.
