ONE DIES, FOUR INJURED AS AUTO HITS SIGNAL STANDARD

Floyd W. Rison, aged 34, 1724 1/2 Oakland Street, was killed instantly and four other persons injured when the auto in which they were riding, pictured herewith, struck a signal standard on Mercer Avenue in Decatur late Saturday night. The auto was wrecked.

Mrs. Rison, her brother, Daniel O'Shaughnessy, aged 25, of Monroeville; Raymond Papenbrock, aged 31, Rural Route No. 1, Monroeville, and Mrs. Papenbrock, were injured in the crash. O'Shaughnessy is not expected to recover. All the injured are patients at Adams County Memorial Hospital.
