BROTHER OF MRS. BEN GERBER DIES

Adam J. Schwartz, 57, died at 2:00 a.m. Saturday at his home one mile south and one-half mile west of Bluffton of heart complications, following an illness of one year.

Born Dec. 26, 1881, in French township, this county, Mr. Schwartz was the son of Edward and Marie Sutter Schwartz. He resided most of his life in Wells county. He was married January 18, 1904, to Mary Narr, who survives.

Surviving besides the widow are two children, Miss Mabel Schwartz, of Fort Wayne, and Edward Schwartz, at home; four sisters, Mrs. Sarah Meyers and Miss Kate Schwartz, both of Bluffton, Mrs. Belle Gerber of Berne, and Mrs. Mary Watson of Florida. A sister and two brothers are deceased.

Mr. Schwartz was a member of the Six Mile Christian Church.

Funeral services were held at 2:00 p.m. today at the residence in charge of Rev. E. C. Geeding. Burial was in the Six Mile cemetery. Quite a number from here attended the funeral.
