Yesterday morning at 2 o'clock occurred the death of Mrs. Addison Sheets, living near Wren. Her death was caused by an attack of the heart. Mrs. Sheets has been in feeble health for some time, but seemed so much better that the doctor deemed it unnecessary to call Wednesday, saying he would defer his visit until Friday. Thursday morning, about 1 o'clock, however, she grew worse, and at 2 o'clock expired. She leaves a husband and two sons, the eldest being ten years old and the youngest but five days of age. The funeral arrangements have been deferred until messages are received from her brothers, one in Washington D.C. and one in California.
