### **FORMER BERNE MAN IS DEAD AT WOODBURN**

**Edwin Sprunger, Aged 62, Dies; Funeral Saturday Afternoon**

Edwin Sprunger, aged 62, a native of this community, died at 3:30 o'clock Wednesday afternoon at his home in Woodburn, according to word received by relatives here late Wednesday afternoon. Death was caused by heart disease. Mr. Sprunger had been ill just a few days.

Mr. Sprunger was a rural mail carrier at Woodburn, a position he had held for many years. He has a large number of close relatives in Berne, including many first cousins.

The deceased was born in Monroe township, Dec. 14, 1874, a son of Christian and Marianna Sprunger. He grew to manhood on his father's farm and moved with his parents to Woodburn many years ago. He was married to Miss Sarah Rupp, who survives.

Two children survive, Myron and Arlo Sprunger.
