Sr. M. Frerericica dies in Wisconsin

Word has been received of the death Friday of Sr. M. Frereica, a native of Adams county, at Nazareth Heights, Fond du Lac, Wis.

Born Catherine Spuller, she was the daughter of Anthony and Mary Louise Kurber-Spuller, pioneer residents of Adams county.

She entered the order of the Sisters of St. Agnes at Fond du Lac, and was professed Jan. 21, 1895. After teaching for some time, she was mistress of novices for many years.

Sr. M. Frerericica was preceded in death by seven sisters, Surviving are a number of nieces and nephews, including Sr. M. Hildegarde, C. S.; Fond du Lac, and Miss Helen Thomas, Mrs. F. R. Costello, and Edward and Ireneaus Gase, all of this city. Funeral services and burial will be at Fond du Lac. (no date)
