## LOCAL LADY'S BROTHER DIES AT FORT WAYNE

Max W. Stonebraker, 51, of 701 Russell avenue, Fort Wayne, died at 2:55 a.m. Thursday at Parkview memorial hospital, where he had been a patient since Nov. 20.

He was an employee of International Harvester before retiring due to illness.
