WIFE OF IRA WAGONER DIES

Well-Known Monroe Woman Dies Tuesday at Her Home

Mrs. Jessie M. Wagoner, age 64, wife of Ira Wagoner, died at her home at Monroe at 10:00 am Tuesday morning from complications. She had been bedfast during the past three weeks.

Funeral services were held at the Monroe M. E. Church Wednesday afternoon at 2:00 with Rev. Elbert Morford, pastor of the church officiating. The body was taken to Perryville, O., early today. Funeral rites were held there and burial was made there.

The deceased was a member of the Monroe M. E. Church. She was born at Washington, Ohio, September 2, 1871, a daughter of John and Telitha Morrison, Her marriage to Mr. Wagoner was an event of September 27, 1932.

She is survived by her husband, two sisters, Mrs. J.J. Stewart and Mrs. Nellie F. Hannan, both of Columbus, Ohio, and brother Charles of Columbus, Ohio.
